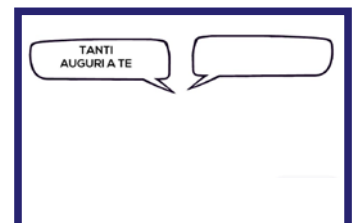
Kindergarten - Graffiti

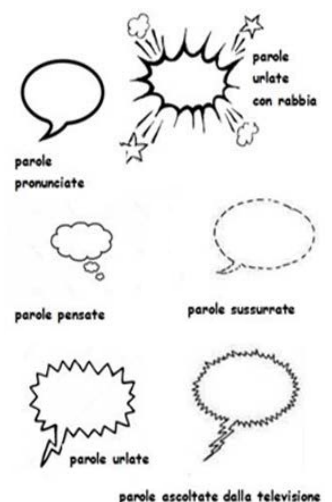
Year 3 & Year 4 - I murales
