Prepare a slideshow in Italian to present the history of comics focusing on their usage to transmit values of friendship, family, respect, and some of the duties and rights of a civil society. Italian Competition 2020". Alternatively, entries can be submitted on a USB that will be returned at the end of the competition. Please ensure the USB is clearly labelled. Maximum 6 slides (80 words in Italian).

Create an Italian comic strip — A local Italian newspaper is looking for new content in the form of comics. You want to submit a comic. Create a comic strip of 6-8 squares using illustrations and speech bubbles in Italian (Maximum 150 words on A4 paper). Your comic strip can be inspired by the following values:

- Friendship
- Love
- Duties and rights of a civil society
- Gratitude
- Respect
