

## The Third Annual Indonesian Language Teacher of the Year Award

The Indonesian Language Program in the School of Humanities and Social Sciences (SHSS) proudly announces the third annual Indonesian Language Teacher of the Year Award which will be given to a teacher of Indonesian at an Australian school. The recipient will receive a certificate that recognises his/her contribution and a return ticket to Jakarta from the closest capital city to his/her location served by the sponsor airline. Airfare from the recipient's closest capital city and one night's accommodation in Melbourne for the award ceremony will also be provided.

#### Indonesian Language Teacher of the Year Award

The award recognises the outstanding contribution of Indonesian language teachers in Australia in classroom teaching and also to Indonesian language teaching and learning activities overall in this country.

#### Nomination process

LOTE coordinators, principals and members of the Department of Education, Catholic Education Office and Independent Schools Association are invited to nominate teachers for the award. There is no nomination form, but the nominator should briefly address the following selection criteria in writing:

- Outstanding teaching ability as reflected in excellent classroom practices, student achievement and satisfaction, etc;
- Commitment to the teaching of Indonesian;
- Encouragement and support for students to begin and maintain the study of Indonesian;
- Contribution to the profile of the Indonesian language within their local community;
- Development of innovative and creative materials for the study of Indonesian at the level of language taught;
- Generation of a spirit of excitement and accomplishment among students of Indonesian; and
- Any other special qualities the nominee may have.


In addition, the nomination must be accompanied by a signed statement from the nominee, approved and signed by his/her Principal, and a brief biography of no more than 100 words. The statement must contain the full contact information of the nominee and indicate that the nominee:

- is a fully qualified teacher of Indonesian currently teaching the subject in an Australian school;
- agrees to being nominated for this award and to attend the award presentation ceremony at Deakin University on October 27 2014; and
- agrees to being featured on the website and in publications of the School of Humanities and Social Sciences and Deakin University for the purpose of raising the profile of Indonesian study and teaching in Australian schools..
