

Selection Criteria

Approval to teach Indonesian and native speaker proficiency in Indonesian. Approval to teach K-6. Capacity to incorporate information communication technology and innovative teaching ideas. Willingness to work as a bilingual team member and to liaise with classroom teachers to develop quality teaching programs across key learning areas within a K-6 setting. Well-developed communication and interpersonal skills with the capacity to build relationships and engage students with adjustments and accommodations, staff, parents and community.

Position Information

Scotts Head is unique, as it is only one of four primary schools in NSW offering students the Bilingual program. The program delivers the regular curriculum for 45 minutes a day in Indonesian, developing language skills, knowledge, understanding and acceptance of Asian societies, cultures and environments.

This supports the ongoing direction of our school to prepare students for their life beyond school. To develop their knowledge, skills and capabilities to be global citizens; enhancing opportunities for our students to effectively live, work and learn in our region, developing the skills to communicate and engage with the peoples of both Asia and the wider world.

Scotts Head Public School is a small school situated in the coastal village of Scotts Head on the Mid North Coast of New South Wales. The school structure consists of three multi-stage classes and a straight Kindergarten. The school has an enrolment of 85 students.
