

## International Competition "Uno, nessuno e centomila"

The International Competition "Uno, nessuno e centomila" is a cultural event that takes place every year in Agrigento, the birthplace of Luigi Pirandello, celebrated Italian playwright and Nobel Prize for Literature.

The initiative, now in its 5th edition, is promoted by the **Fondazione Teatrale** "**Luigi Pirandello**", in collaboration with the Ministry of Education, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, the Municipality of Agrigento, the "Valle dei Templi" tourism district, the association" La Strada degli Scrittori" and the Academy of Fine Arts Michelangelo.

The competition intends to reflect on the overall meaning of Luigi Pirandello's work through the Theatre, as a pedagogical tool capable of profoundly affecting the cognitive and emotional growth of the person.

The **competition** is open to students of lower and upper secondary schools who will have to present a dramaturgical text (written individually or in a group) **in italian** taken from a short story by Pirandello, or a performance of a theatrical adaptation of a short story by the same author.

The works, accompanied by the **application form**, explaining the work and containing both the personal data of the participants and the data of the student's school. The application must be received by and no later than 11.59 pm on **20 February 2022** to the e-mail address:

Each school can participate with more than one work.

The award ceremony will take place in Agrigento on a date that will be communicated directly to the school. All finalist students will be able to represent the work selected by the Commission, as long as they undertake to direct it.
