#### CLARIFICATIONS FOR REGISTRATIONS

New applications will be submitted during the registration period.

**Applications approved:** Those who have applied will not make a new submission. The application remains valid if they have been approved by the Sydney Examination Center.

**Applications for submission:** They can be submitted permanently from 1/6.

**Applications in process:** these are applications that the candidates had started and did not manage to complete or submit. They will now be able to edit and submit it.

**Change of level:** If there are candidates who want to change level, there is this possibility.
